FRENCH I

I. General Objective:

This course aims to provide students with the skills and competencies necessary to master the French language.

II. Specific Objectives: By the end of the session, the student should be able to:

- Understand how to arrange words and construct sentences according to the rules of French grammar.
- Use essential methods for organizing intellectual work.
- Communicate thoughts effectively in both oral and written forms.

III. Course Outline:

Week 1: Introduction to the noun group, including its constituents, gender, and number of common nouns, as well as different types of determiners.

Week 2: The complement of the noun, the qualifying adjective, its functions, agreements, and relative or subordinate clauses.

Week 3: Personal pronouns, tonic pronouns, pronouns for pronominal verbs, object pronouns, and demonstrative, possessive, indefinite, interrogative, and relative pronouns.

Week 4: Basic rules of French spelling, including the agreement of adjectives, past participles, verbs, and the differences between c/cu/ç and g/ge/gu, and e/é/è.

Week 5: Midterm exam.

Week 6: Different types of sentences and how to recognize them, the importance of structuring a plan, and mastering the French language.

Week 7: Verbs, their moods, and tenses.

Week 8: French punctuation rules and how to use them.

Week 9: General course review.
