FRENCH II

I. Description of the Course:

This course is designed for individuals who are capable of communicating fluently in French but wish to improve their vocabulary, mastery of verb tenses, pronouns, writing, and text comprehension. Students are encouraged to put into practice orally and in writing what they learn, and they will have multiple opportunities to do so during the course. FRA 102 specifically aims to meet the needs of Haitian professionals who must use French in their professional practice.

II. What the student will learn:

1. Acquire and use a broader vocabulary and employ corresponding expressions correctly.
2. Master the main past tenses in oral and written communication.
3. Master the subjunctive in oral and written expression.
4. Properly use pronouns.
5. Compose texts, including:
 - Summaries
 - Syntheses
 - Argumentative essays
6. Comprehend texts from French literature.
